The Great Blue Hole

Have you ever heard of The Great Blue Hole? This is one of the most stunning locations that remains undiscovered by many people. The name may seem self-explanatory, but it doesn't fully capture its essence. The Great Blue Hole is a giant marine sinkhole off the coast of Belize. Located near the center of Lighthouse Reef, a small atoll situated 70 km from the mainland and Belize City. The hole boasts a circular shape, with a diameter of 318 m and a depth of 124 m. Its surface area measures 70,650 square meters. It is a world heritage site protected by the Belize Audubon Society and is a must-visit destination for scuba divers.



The Great Blue Hole is a network of intricate limestone caves. It was above ground before being submerged by melting ice caps 14,000 years ago. Today, it measures 300 meters in width and remains an astonishing and largely unexplored marvel of nature. Many divers enjoy exploring the beautiful and colorful marine life while diving. However, the Great Blue Hole is home to many unique and interesting creatures that thrive in the surrounding coral. Blue holes are underwater sinkholes that contain unique seawater chemistry and diverse marine life, including corals, sponges, mollusks, sea turtles, and sharks. This dive location is known to have the highest number of diver fatalities in the world, with an estimated total of 130 to 200 fatalities in recent years. However, the reasons behind this alarming statistic are not yet fully understood. The sinkhole located in Belize's Lighthouse Reef has been described by NASA as a large circular formation with a deep blue center surrounded by a sea of lighter colors. This contrast makes it easily visible even from space. The surrounding atoll, which is made up of shallow


The ceremony, held on 21st September 2023 was a reflection of our commitment to fostering leadership, responsibility, and excellence within our community.
